Objectives and challenges

Implementation

- / Strengthen surveillance and management of our infrastructure to anticipate and reduce occurrence of incidents.
- / Strengthen our performance indicators and share them with everyone.
- / Amplify HSE operational control by simplifying our local management tools (Audits, risk assessments, etc.).
- / Resize our workspaces to meet our SQCD issues.
- / Maintain inclusion of energy aspects in our investments.

Responsibilities and commitments

- / Individual contribution of each employee (vigilance, good practices, compliance with instructions, common sense, etc.) to this policy is expected in their function.
- / The hierarchy, staff representatives, the CSSCT, and the committees of Matra Électronique (in particular in context of new investments and new business) contribute to the correct application of this policy.
